

STAGE NOTES

One of my earliest childhood memories involves jumping on the furniture in my basement on the south side of Chicago while singing songs from Disney's *Aladdin*. My favorite lyric was from the *One Jump Ahead Reprise* where Aladdin sings about how he sees himself and his future:

Riff-raff, street rat, I don't buy that, If only they'd look closer, Would they see a poor boy? No siree they'd find out **there's so much more to me**,

I felt like I was flying when I would sing and watch Magic Carpet fly through the cave of wonders. My mom wasn't so sure.

However, that's the magic of the arts.

Through animation, song, and storytelling, a 4-year-old boy believed there was a bigger world and a greater adventure out there. Aladdin was a boy with the odds stacked against him from the outset, but he was able to cross-cultural, socio-economic, and social boundaries to become a prince, a hero, and a friend.

We started this season with a simple statement: There is no THEM, only US. When we look at the problems, struggles, and needs in this world, we cannot wait around and hope that someone ELSE fixes things. We have to be the change by appreciating what makes each of us unique, while celebrating all that connects us as humans.

The musical you are about to enjoy is in both Spanish and English. Several of our guests will be native Spanish speakers who have never seen a musical in their native language. If we didn't decide to push our students outside their comfort zone, how would they know the joy of giving someone the gift of dignity by performing in the language they grew up speaking?

I've heard many students (and parents) who didn't believe we could pull off a bilingual production, but as I sit in a rehearsal surrounded by 60 students singing *A Whole New World* in two languages, I am reminded that we often have to see and believe in the amazing potential of our students long before *"they find out, there's so much more to"* them.

There is no place I would rather do this work than here at Mount Vernon with our amazing team of MV Artists; the students and instructors who teach me so much each day. Enjoy the show and be sure to join us next year for our most adventurous season yet!
